


This week in BCS we celebrate our diversity during Yellow Flag Week.

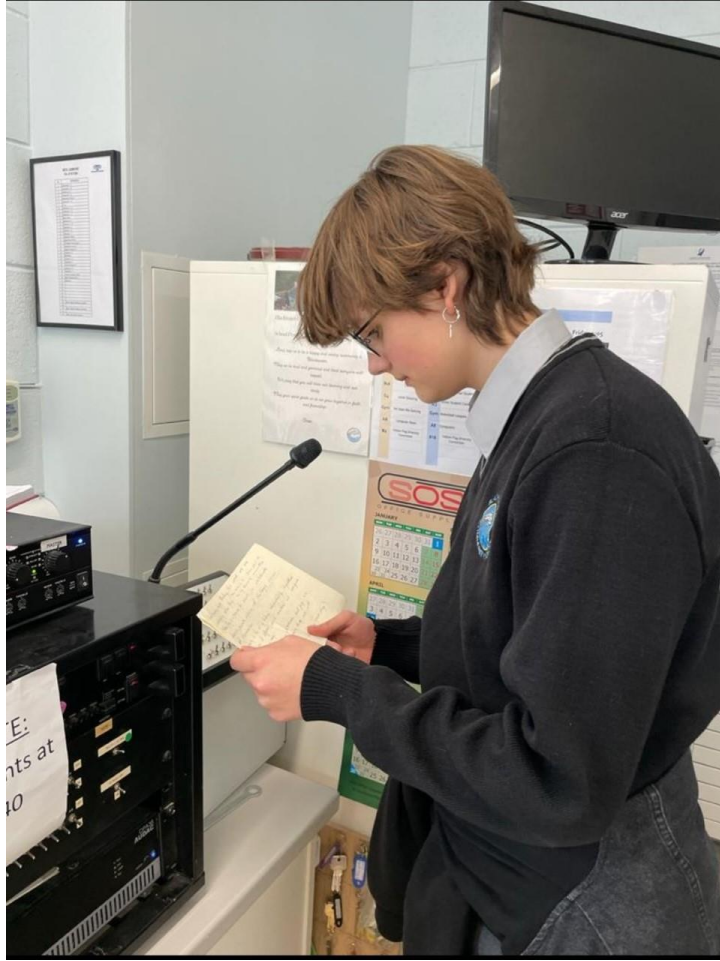
- Meet our Yellow Flag Diversity Committee
