

Yellow Flag week continued... Wednesday 19th & Thursday 20th

On Wednesday 19th Mowahedah Saifi from Afghanistan told us about how long she had been living in Tallow and her admiration for Kofi Annan.




On Thursday 20th Yaroslav Andreiev told us about his life in Ukraine and sadly how Russian soldiers occupied his house for many months.




Class based work
