### Recognising a need



- Parenting Hub's have been established in Ireland since 2013. They came about when it was recognised of the difficulty faced by parents in accessing information about what services are there to support them and their families. It was, with this in mind, agreed that there was the need for a "One Stop Shop". An **online** service to provide information to parents where they could find out about services, and get information and advice around parenting issues.
- Waterford CYPSC Family Support Sub Group then identified the need for a Parenting Hub in Waterford. Funding was secured, BRILL FRC got the tender and WPH Began in November 2020
- WPH role involves developing strong partnerships between agencies involved in the provision of parenting programmes and supports, as well as supporting services for parents and agencies in coordination and information provision.
- WPH also promotes the accessibility of Parenting Programmes to all parents. High quality group programmes can provide parents with helpful advice and guidance around different strategies to aid them through what sometimes can be a challenging time in their lives. Parents who have attended programmes in the past often highlight the support they have felt from talking with other parents in the group and we believe that this support should be available no matter where you live in Waterford. We have launched a Training Calendar, delivering a variety of evidenced based / evidenced informed programmes in the coming months. These programmes will be held in the community or over Zoom & each FRC has assess and visibility of the calendar. We hope to get it live to the everyone soon..

## **Interagency Work**

### The purpose of this will be to:

- Build a database of who is trained to run what programmes, exploring projects, collaborating based on expertise and generally looking to bring additionality to the services who are already providing support to families.
- Communicate by assisting in the advertising of courses/training/supports and sign-post local people to local service
- A monthly calendar for FRC's and other groups to see what is upcoming in training courses as needs are identified by parents or professionals within their community





## Coordinate, collaberate & deliver

- Coordinate with local services & professionals which will allow for courses to run in local areas e.g. bring groups with the same identified need together to achieve numbers to run a particular course
- Collaborate & Deliver with co facilitators to run the course in your area
- Let the calendar of training be a visible reference to upcoming courses
- Build a register for expressions of interest to run courses on identified needs


